3. Official Copy of High School or College Transcript in sealed envelope
4. Letter of Acceptance - first time and transfer college students
5. Two current Letters of Recommendation from Nonrelatives (One of your recommendations must be your Pastor or Church Official and the second can be from a mentor, teacher, counselor, friend etc.) Recommendations must be signed.

Application must be postmarked by July 31, 2023. Incomplete and Late applications will not be considered.

FYI: Applications will be processed during the months of September and October. Checks will be distributed during the month of November. Applicants not receiving a scholarship will be notified at the same time as the awarded.
